For the upcoming May 6, 2014 Primary Election, Ohio voters will choose candidates for a number of statewide and local offices. Ohioans will also have the chance to vote on one Statewide Ballot Issue:

- Issue 1 – Proposed Constitutional Amendment: To Fund Public Infrastructure Capital Improvements By Permitting The Issuance Of General Obligation Bonds
